MONTENEGRO:

PEOPLE (Total 626 000): Slavic 92,2% (*Montenegrin 46.7%, Serb 34.6%, Bosniak 8.4%, Croat 1.2%, Slovak 1%*) Albanian 5,6%, Romani 0,7%, Others 0,9%

RELIGIONS: Christian 77.05%, Orthodox 71.62%, Catholic 5.28%, Protestant 0.1% Muslim 15%, Non-religious 7.8%, **(only <0.1% EVANGELICAL)**

Most of the Orthodox Christians are Serbian Orthodox, but there is a faction of Montenegrin Orthodox that broke off from the majority and now they have a lot of conflict.

Languages used: Montenegrin, Serbian, Russian

Pentecostal Churches: In Bar, Kamenari, Podgorica, Niksic, Ulcinj, Bjelo Polje, and Kotor (see the map). Only 150 people attend their services!



UNREACHED PEOPLE GROUPS:

BOSNIAKS, mostly Muslim, 11% of the population, have lots of hostility towards Christians because of the violent history in Balkans in the 1990s

No Evangelical churches or groups of believers in the **ALBANIAN** communities, they are a big unreached people group

ROMA are poor and despised by the main population and unreached, but receptive to the gospel compared with other people groups
